I, Harrison Joyner, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, do make this paper writing to be my last will and testament in the following form & manner to wit:
Item 1st I give to Timothy Langston all the lands from a sasafus. Stake near William Griffin's corner down a line of marked trees to the White Oak Spring down the run to Nealey's line all on the South side, the number of acres not known and the following negroes named & her children and her grand children and their increase & one half of my other property to him & his heirs forever.
Item 2nd I give to Thos. Hall & Susan his wife all the Lands on the north side of Timothy's line, the number of acres not known and all the Stills Applemill & apparatus with the following negroes Siraos, Jane and all her children and grand children and their increase to them and their heirs forever. I also give Thos. Hall half the Balance of my estate not given away to him & his heirs forever. It is my will & desire that my Executors hereafter named sell sell at their discretion all the timbers on the lands known as the Love Lands and Lotz Bradshaw Lands and then sell the Lands as they may see fit and the proceeds of the sales to be equally divided as follows, one fourth to Timothy E. Langston, one fourth part to Thos. Hall, one fourth to Rosiller Joyner, one fourth to the children Samuel E. Parker that may then be living and if either one of his children die to the next surviving child, If all die then to T. E. Langston, T. Hall and Rosiller Joyner.
Item 3rd It is my will & desire that my Executors select two good persons and have all the Land appraised and negroes with all the Chattel property appraised and pay as follows T. E. Langston to pay to L. E. Parker's children one fourth of the valuation to be as above described and T. Hall to pay to Rosiller Joyner one fourth of the valuation, And I desire at my death that my money be divided in the same manner as above described and I hereby constitute and appoint Thos. Hall and Timothy E. Langston my Executors to this my last will and testament. Given under
