Item 12th I give and bequeath unto D^r Robert Murray his heirs forever, is
ten shares of a Norfolk City Stock.

Item 13th I give & bequeath unto Putnam Owen Pastor of the Baptist &
(or therein) five shares of a Norfolk City Stock to him & his heirs forever.

Item 14th I give & bequeath to James Holmes Sr (or Holmes) ten shares of a Nor-
folk City Stock, and I give to James Holmes Jr son of the said James Holmes
ten shares of a Norfolk City Stock to him & his heirs forever.

Item 15th I give and bequeath unto S. Junius Wilson the bond of four hundred
dollars I hold against him and also ten shares of a Norfolk City Stock.

Item 16th I give & bequeath to John Wiggins son of Exam Wiggins ten shares
of a Norfolk City Stock to him & his heirs forever.

Item 17. I give & bequeath to Bartley Beal (or Beal) son of Bartley Beal dec^d &
whose mother is a niece of the late Alexander Myrick dec^d ten shares of a Nor-
folk City Stock, to him the said Bartley Beal forever.

Item 18th I give to Margaret Jones daughter of the late Henry Jones dec^d a
preacher the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars; and I give to Mary Jones, the
widow, that lives near me the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars.

Item 19th The residue of my estate not herein before disposed of & after
the payment of all debts & charges against the same I give and bequeath
unto Bartley (or Beal) Bowers and his heirs forever. And
Lastly, I do hereby constitute & appoint the said Bartley Bowers and Ludlow
Lawrence, the executors of this my will and testament and I request that
the County Court of Southampton will permit them to qualify without
demanding any security.
