Your Commissioner reports to Court that Wm. W. Joyner & Jos. T. Joyner the Administrators of Joseph Joyner has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Administrators or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$1944. 17 to be due by the said Administrators to the said Estate on the 18th day of February 1861 with interest on \$1929. 77 from that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and that the said Executors has given such bond as the law requires, the principal whereof and the securities thereof are sufficient in the opinion of the Commissioner.
