To the County Court of Southampton County

Your Commissioner reports to Court that George W. Vick Sheriff and administrator of Arthur Whitehead has exhibited before him a Statement of all money received by the said administrator or with which he had become chargeable, or had disbursed, during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$14.02 to be due by the said Administrator to the said estate on the 15th day of August 1861 with interest thereon from that day.
