

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 19th day of May, 1862. This writing bearing date 2nd day of December 1861, purporting the last will & testament of Samuel Greory, dec^d, was produced in Court and the subscribing witnesses thereto being absent in service of the Confederate Army, James Greory & William H. Greory being sworn & solemnly deposed and said that they were well acquainted with the hand writing of the said Samuel Greory and truly believe the said will as well as the signatures thereto to be in the proper hand writing of the said Samuel Greory. Whereupon it is ordered that the said writing be recorded as and for the last will & testament of the said Samuel Greory, dec^d, and on the motion of William S. Gordon, one of the Executors therein named, who made oath and together with Benjamin W. Gordon, Francis S. Ridley and Thomas Ridley, his son, entered (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred and fifty thousand dollars, conditioned according to law, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form, liberty being reserved to the other Executors therein named to be joined in the said probat when they may think fit.
