I William Grizzard of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, do make this my last Will and Testament in the manner following to wit:

1st I wish my wife to keep my estate together for the purpose of raising and educating my children, she to manage it such way as she thinks best for the interest of our children, and in the event of her marriage again, then I wish her to have only one third part of my estate, in addition to my woman Louisa and her future increase, the said woman and increase not to be estimated allotting her, her thirds.

2 I wish the sum of Eight hundred dollars to be expended in the education of my son Franklin.

3 I wish the sum of Twelve hundred dollars to be expended in educating my son William F.D. Grizzard.

4 I give to my daughter Virginia H Richardson the sum of five hundred dollars, the said sum to be paid her either at the death or marriage of my wife.

5 I give to my daughter Rosa B. the sum of four hundred dollars, to be paid at the same time mentioned in the preceding clause.

6 To my daughter Mary Ann Four hundred dollars, to be paid at the time in Item the 5th.

I wish my Executor hereinafter named to sell the tract of land I own in the County of Sussex to the best advantage either publicly or privately and to devote the proceeds of sale to the pay of tract of land of which I purchased of the estate of Joel Harris.

At the death of my wife I wish the whole of my property to be equally divided between my children, the legacies to my children, given in this will to be first paid.

Lastly, I nominate E. W. Mason Executor to this my last will, with the request that he will act. In Witness of all which, I hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of June eighteen hundred and sixty.
