In the name of God, Amen: I Caswell Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say
 Item 1st I wish my Executor to sell off all that he thinks can be spared from the farm as soon after my death as he thinks best and at the end of the year sell all that I have except my land and pay off all my just debts, burial expenses &c.
 Item 2nd I give to Eveline Bhammel one hundred dollars in cash or bonds, but should she die leaving no child then her portion is to go to Dorthulien Drake
 Item 3rd I leave to Mary Drake the house and 8 acres of land that I bought of Kirby Vick during her life only
 Item 4th I give to Dorthulien Drake all the balance of my property of every kind I have left after paying the above legacies including the land loaned to Mary Drake after her death I wish my executor to give Dorthulien a tolerable good common education and pay her expenses of board, clothing, tuition, books &c out of her portion while going to school.
