Your Commissioner reports to Court that William W Cobb one of the executors of James T Butts has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said executor or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed, during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$2906.33 to be due by the said Executor to the said estate on the 16th day of July 1862, with interest on \$2795.61 from that day.
