Your Commissioner reports that at the request of George W Vick Sheriff and Administrator of Wm J Porter deceased he issued notices on the 19 day of Sept. 1862 to the creditors of the estate of the said Wm J Porter deceased, and all others concerned which notices were posted up at the Courthouse door of Southampton County Court, on two successive terms of said County Court, to wit, at October and November Terms 1862 that he would on the 19 day of November 1862, proceed to take an account of all debts or demands against the said decedent or his estate at his office, at which time and place, the creditors whose names are mentioned in the foregoing account appeared and proved their debts or demands to the satisfaction of your Commissioner. Which debts with interest included up to the 20 day of November 1862 amounts to \$37.67 and are all of the same or fourth class, and there is a sufficiency in the hands of the Administrator, pay them. -
