To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that George W Vick Sheriff and the administrator of Adam Seutchins has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said administrator or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed, during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements.
