Your Commissioner reports to Court that at the request of George W Vick Sheriff & Administrator of James W Stephenson deceased, he issued notices on the 19th day of Sept. 1862, to the Creditors of the Estate of the said James W Stephenson deceased and all others concerned, which notices were posted up at the front door of the courthouse of Southampton on the first day of two Successive Terms of said County Court, to wit, at October and November Term 1862, proceeded to take an account of all the debts or demands against the said decedent or his estate, at his Office. At which time and place the creditor whose name is mentioned in the foregoing account appeared and proved his debt to the satisfaction of your Commissioner, which debt with interest included up to the 16th day of December 1862, amounts to \$2.11⁴ and is of the fourth class & there is a sufficiency in the hands of the Administrator to pay the same.
