To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that Thomas Ridley the Executor of Robert Ridley has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Executor or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed, during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements.
