To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that Thomas Ridley the Executor of Robert Ridley has exhibited before him a statement of all money received by the said Executor or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of £ 33063. 03 to be due by the said Executor to the said estate on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1862, with interest thereon from that day.
