Your Commissioner reports to Court that Davis Barrett, Jas. J. Darden & Rich. J. Darden the Executors of Richard Darden has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Executors or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed, during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$16555. 84 to be due by the said Executors to the said estate on the 31st day of December 1862 with interest on \$16227. 33 from that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and that the said Executors have given such bond as the law requires, the penalty whereof and the securities thereto are sufficient in the opinion of the Commissioner.
