To the County Court of Southampton County

Your Commissioner reports to Court, that on the 18th day of May last, at the request of John Moore the administrator of the estate of Moody Smith dec^d he appointed the 6th day of July last, at his office at the Court house of said County, for receiving proof of debts or demands against the said decedent or his estate. & posted a notice (a copy of which is hereto appended) of such time & place to the Creditors of the said estate & all others concerned, at the front door of the Court house of said County, on the first day of two successive terms of the County Court of said County, to wit. at June & July terms last. That the several creditors of the said estate whose names are mentioned in the foregoing account, appeared before the Commissioner at his said Office, upon the day specified in the notice, & at intervals between the time of advertising & that day, & exhibited & proved to the satisfaction of your Commissioner, their several debts or demands against the decedent or his estate, as set forth in the said account, upon which the Commissioner has computed the interest up to the 1st of the present month (September) and classified them according to their respective legal dignities, & on the said 1st day of Sept finds the aggregate amount of said debts or demands, inclusive of interest to be \$1172.28¢
