 Item 1st I give to Benjamin J. Nicholson the sum of five hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item 2nd I give to Sally Beckey Sikes one negr man named Solomon, to her and her heirs forever.

Item 3rd All the rest and residue of my estate of every nature & kind whatsoever after the payment of funeral expenses and just debts I give to David W. Nicholson and his heirs forever.

I Constitute and appoint David W. Nicholson Executor of this my last Will and Testament. Witness my hand and seal this 31st day of August 1863.
