

Seventh. All the bonds and accounts I hold against my son in law Doct. B. F. Persons, my son James H. and my son Junius R. Persons. I give the amount due from each to each of them & their heirs and assigns forever.

Eighth. I give and bequeath my gold watch to my son Walter to him and his heirs forever.

Ninth. If at the expiration of four years my children do not desire a division of their property I desire the same to be kept together as long as my Executors may deem it best for their benefit.

Tenth. I nominate and appoint my sons James H. Persons and Junius R. Persons Executors to this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills and testaments made by me.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 22^d day of December A.D. 1863.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 16th day of January 1864
This last will and testament of John A. Person dec^d was proved by the oaths of Joseph H. Preece and G. A. Musgrave the subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of James H. Persons and Junius R. Persons the Executors therein named who made oaths and together with John Whitehead, William G. Davis and Benjamin G. Turner their securities (who justified on oaths as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.
