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Your Commissioner, at the request of the Admor. States, that the whole amount which at any time came into the hands of the Admor. was in Confederate Treasury notes & that the said amount was apportioned among the creditors according to law. & was directed to be paid to them by an order of the County Court of Southampton at the October Term 1863; & that the debts with which the Admor. is credited in the aforesaid account, except the fees and taxes have been paid in pursuance of said order; that some of the creditors refused to receive Confederate money in payment of their debts which left a balance in the hands of the Admor. at the time the Confederate Congress taxed this currency 33's per Cent. of \$4486.490. & that, under these circumstances, your Commr. has allowed him credit for said deduction, amounting to \$1295.490.
