I Jesse Furgason of the County of Southampton State of Va do hereby make this my last will in manner and form following, to wit,

1st I Will that my Executor, who I shall hereafter name, at suitable time after my death sell all my land & other property of every kind except such as I shall here next otherwise dispose of & out of the proceeds of such sale pay all my just debts & other expenses that may accrue by the execution of this my will and the balance that may be found due my estate put out at interest to be applied as I shall herein direct -

2^d I give and bequeath to my wife Sidney Furgason Seventy five dollars worth of any kind of property that she may of the property of my estate taken at the appraisal to her & her heirs forever -

Further: I give to my wife Sidney Furgason during her natural life the interest that may accrue annually from the amount due my estate - and I also give to my said wife during her life the sum of twenty dollars taken out of the amount found due my estate -

3rd I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Henryether Edwards wife of John Edwards the sum of One hundred dollars to be paid to her at the death of my wife Sidney Furgason -

4th I give & bequeath the balance of my estate that then is to be equally divided between the then living children of my grand-daughter Henryether to them and their heirs forever -

5th I request & ordain James Barnes of Stafford County Executor to this my last Will and Testament - Signed, Sealed and acknowledged this 12th day of August, year 1860 -
