Item 2^d. After the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses. I give and bequeath all of the remaining part of my estate to my sister Jane Loncier, to her and her heirs forever 3^d and lastly I constitute and appoint my sister Jane Loncier Executrix to this my last Will and Testament.
