The Commissioner is requested by the Executor to state specially that the balance due in his first account. Viz. \$6898.46 cts. from the estate of Saml. Drury decd. was derived from the sale of property mainly in Decr 1862: at which time Confederate money was nearly at par, and from bonds and accounts due before the war commenced the payments made as stated in the above account under the directions of the will, are very nearly equal to the legatee's portion derived from the sale of property and consequently the above balance is regarded by the executor as due in specie or its equivalent. in the early part of 1863 a part of the above balance was invested in Confederate bonds which were sold by the executor during the same year and the amount lost by the destruction of the Confederate States government. The Commissioner states further for himself that he has found great difficulty in the settlement of the account from the Executors having made out one portion in federal currency and the other in Confederate States currency and he has found it necessary
