

and he has found it necessary to make three distinct accounts. the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 1<sup>st</sup> 1864. with a balance due the legatee of \$6898. 46 ct. in Federal Currency as directed by the executor, the second of Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> 1864 of \$24410. 85 ct. balance due the legatee in Confederate States currency. The third of Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> 1865 of \$731. 88 ct. balance the legatee in Federal currency - All of which is respectfully submitted. But the Legislature having at its last Session by law authorized or permitted the Courts to reduce Confederate currency to its true value at the time of the contract made or at such other time as to the Court may seem right, therefore in order to harmonize the accounts, the Commissioner has made out the following account reducing the Confederate currency to Federal currency by a scale prepared by Messrs. Purcell & Co. brokers in Richmond for the Legislature, but which scale was omitted in the act as passed, it being the intention of the Legislature to let each case be adjudged by its own merits. The Commissioner states further that Saml. Drury's will having made the executor a continuator of trustee he shall not compound interest on him, but state his account as a trustee.
