Item 1st I give to Maria Pope (freed woman of color) one hundred (\$100) dollars in money, to be raised and paid out of my estate -

Item 2^d after paying all my debts - I lend to my daughter Mary Davis Holland all the money that arise from the sale of my perishable estate during her life and at her death to be returned and equally divided between her children - Also the whole of my landed estate I lend to her during her life, and at her death to be equally divided between her children
