Your Commissioner would report to the Court that this large balance due the Estate on the 1st day of April 1865 is in Confederate money and that he is requested by the Executor to state that at and for sometime previous to the Surrender of Gen. Lee he had the above balance in his hands; which he was anxious to invest, but was unable to get there for that purpose and in fact owing to the critical times and circumstances in which he was placed, the uncertainty as to what was the best course to pursue with Confederate money, he was at a loss, what to do, and consequently was caught with this large balance of \$27,770.91 on his hands which is now worthless. Your Commissioner further states that the Executor now holds not included in the account 50 Shares Confederate Seven Per Cent Stock for which he paid \$5,000 invested by order of the Court.
