Your Commissioner would report specially that in settling the accounts for the transactions of James B. Varguhart as Admin of the Estate of A. B. Varguhart, he settled two accounts, one of his Confederate transactions, and the foregoing an account of his transactions in U. S. Currency, and that as the amount of the account of Self was due in Gold, it will be readily seen that the above balance stands against the administrator in Gold. Your Commissioner further reports, that he has not charged the Admin. with interest, nor has he allowed him any interest on his advances to the Estate, either in this account or the account of his Confederate transactions, from the fact that during the whole time embraced in both accounts the advancements so alternated between the Estate and the Admin, that your Commissioner was
