In the Name of God amen. I Martha M. Griffin of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being feeble in health but of sound and disposing mind do hereby Ordain and Make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows (to wit:)

1st I give to Martha and Susan Mangrum all the property belonging to me in their possession also a bond I hold against the estate; one half dozen plates to each one to them and their heirs forever.

2^d I give to Figgys Bulls one feather bed first choice, 2 pillows, 4 Sheets, 4 bed quilts and 4 counterpane, also I leave her ^{with} balance of my estate during her natural life after paying my just debts, to live upon and furthermore my Land so long as she live and at her death I wish John Mangrum to have my Land him and his heirs forever, and the balance of my Chattel Estate if she does not live to consume it to be equally divided between the Mangrum children (namely) Martha, Susan & John Mangrum.

Now last of all I appoint Zachariah Doyel my Executor to this my last Will and Testament revoking all other heretofore made by me in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal February 1st day 1864.
