

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 19th day of September 1866.

This last Will and Testament of Martha M. Griffin d. d. was this day proved by the solemn affirmation of Zachariah Doyel, Joseph J. Harris and John Turner the Subscribing Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Zachariah Doyel the Executor therein named, who made solemn affirmation and together with John Paston and John Turner, his Securities, (who justified in solemn form as to their sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred and fifty dollars, Conditioned as the Law directs, which bond having Stamps of the Internal Revenue of the United States of the amount of One dollar, is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Zachariah Doyel for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form, Stamps of the Internal Revenue of the United States of the amount of One dollar being affixed hereto.
