I William Stephenson, of the County of Southampton and State of Va. do make
 constitute and Ordain this writing as and for my last Will and Testament
 in manner and form as follows.

Item 1st: I give unto my Son William L. Stephenson, all my land lying on
 the South Side of Seacock Swamp including my home tract, Jagers tract,
 Johnson tract, Brister and Lowe tracts, (Reserving a home and support
 for my two single daughters Catharine Stephenson and Sally A. Ely,
 during their single lives,) also one feather bed and furniture, One mahogany
 writing desk, One two barrel still, One apple mill and One mule, to
 him and his heirs forever.

Item 2nd: I give unto my Son Peter W. Stephenson, my tract of Land
 lying on the North Side of Seacock Swamp known as the Council
 tract also one feather bed and furniture, One walnut desk that
 sits in the Chamber to him and his heirs forever.

Item 3rd: I give unto my daughter Martha A. Darden, the land I hold
 against her husband Charles H. Darden and interest accruing
 thereon, also one feather bed and furniture she has in possession, to her and
 her heirs forever.

Item 4th: I give unto my two daughters Catharine Stephenson and Sally A.
 Ely, each five hundred dollars and one feather bed & furniture, to
 them and their heirs forever.

Item 5th: I give unto my Granddaughter Almida E. B. Jones, five hundred
 dollars, one feather bed and furniture, that I loan to her Mother.

Item 6th: At my death it is my wish that the rest of my property
 not heretofore named be sold and the proceeds arising from
