 make and declare this to be my last will and Testament, revoking all others. After all of my
 just and legal debts are paid I make the following disposition of my property:-
 1st: To James Ghosom son of Dr Robert A. Ghosom, I give my gold watch and key.
 2^d: The Balance of my Estate I leave in the hands of a Trustee, for the benefit of Dr Robert A.
 Ghosom & his wife during their lives, and at their deaths (viz. Dr Robert A. Ghosom & wife) I
 give the property equally to Martha C. Ghosom, Thomas S. Ghosom, Mary B. Ghosom, James Ghosom
 and Robert A. Ghosom Jr; or to their heirs of the body, if any of the above named should be dead.
 3^d: I furthermore request the Court of Dinwiddie County, State of Virginia, to appoint a Trustee
 to take charge of my property during the life of Dr Robert A. Ghosom & wife, and to pay over
 to them, the annual income of my Estate.
 4th: I do furthermore request that the Trustee, appointed by said Court expend any part of the
 Estate, that he may think proper and beneficial, for Land, for the benefit of the abovesaid
 heirs. In testimony whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and placed my Seal,
 this 17th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Six.
