Item 7th: The balance of my Estate of whatever kind it may be I desire equally divided by Sale or otherwise between my Sons, Robert B. Prichard, W^m St. Prichard and Charles F. Prichard, to them and their Heirs forever.

Item 6th: I give my son Charles F. Brewster, the tract of Land bought of Martha Cope, lying on Proctor's road at and near the ferry, to him and his heirs forever, containing one hundred and eighteen acres.

Item 9^t. Lastly I hereby appoint all four of my Sons Executors of this my last Will and Testamens and desire the Court to require no Security of them. ~ Witness my hand and Seal this 13th day of November One thousand eight hundred and Sixty five. ~
