To the County Court of Southampton County.
 Your Commissaries report that at the request of James H. Person and
 Junius R. Person, Executors of John A. Person decd. he examined
 their Vouchers and Made up the foregoing accounts of their Executors
 proceedings. Account "A." is of their proceedings in Confederate
 money, and shows a balance due by the Executors to the estate on
 the 30th day of April 1865. of \$454.80 in Confederate money,
 with interest on \$420.36, from that day, and that they have
 in their hands \$14,000.00 in Confederate interest bearing Notes or
 bonds. Account "B." is a joint account of their proceedings, and
 shows a balance due by them to the estate, on the 17th day of
 September 1866. (When James H. Person, one of the Executors power
 was revoked by order of the County Court of Southampton County)
 of \$830.12 as follows, to wit; \$142.31 in gold, with
 interest on \$133.00 from that day, \$47.00 in Silver, with interest
 on \$43.94, from that day, \$236.03 in State Bank Money
 (which is very nearly worthless) and the balance of \$401.78 in
 United States Currency. With interest thereon from that day.
 Account "C." is an account of Junius R. Person's transactions
 and shows a balance due by him to the estate on the 1st day of
 March, 1867, of \$175.48 in United States Currency, with interest
