Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Geo. F. Jollie decd. with his will aforesaid annexed in and found. It being declared on oath that the Estate real and personal of the said Geo. F. Jollie does not exceed in Value the Sum of One Thousand dollars.
