Item 1st: I give and bequeath to my five children Chippy Luter, Elizabeth Luter, Nancy Luter, Sarah Luter and Elias Luter, the plantation wherun I now reside to each of them to have and to hold as a home as long as they or any of them may live.

Item 2^d: My will and desire is after my decease that my Executors shall as publick or private Sale such property as can best be Sparad to Satisfy all my debts if any, the balance of my Chattel estate I give to my above named children.

Item 3rd: I do hereby Nominate and appoint my friend Alfred T. Stephenson, as my Executor to this my last Will and Testament revoking all other Wills heretofore by me made. In testamony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 7th day of November A.D. 1865.
