

In the Name of God amen. I John Crumpler of Southampton County and State of Virginia being in Sound Mind do Make & constitute this my last Will and Testament. Firstly After paying all of my just debts I leave to Robert Sigg, the Son of Matilda Sigg (S. N.) all of my Land on the South Side of the R. & P. Rail Road, until the said Robert Sigg arrives to the age of twenty one years, which will be the date of June 5th 1872. Now if the said Robert Sigg is still living at that date, I give and bequeath the said Land to him. The balance of my Land on the North Side of the Rail Road to remain until the date (1872) to be rented or leased on such terms as my Executors choose to do, and one half of the rent money to be given to James Sigg, Son of Georgeanna Johnson (S. N.) and the other half to Calvin J. Hargrave the Son of Benjamin Hargrave (S. N.) and then I wish it to be sold and the proceeds divided between the said Calvin J. Hargrave, (one half) and the other half to be divided between the daughters of Matilda Sigg, that is living equally. I give to Robert Sigg, one pair of Saddle Cart wheels, and one wheel OO, after paying my debts, the balance of money if any, I give unto Joseph B. Crumpler's children. My debts I give to Geo. E. Crumpler, Son of Jos. B. Crumpler. If the said Robert Sigg should die before that date (1872) the said Land to belong to Matilda Sigg, daughters. I wish Semmons S. Solis and William E. Wrenn to settle my Estate, Given Under my hand and Seal this 23rd day of March Eighteen hundred and Sixty five.
