To the County Court of Southampton County,

Your Commissioner reports that Eliza D. Davis, administratrix of Madison J. Davis decd. has exhibited before him a Statement of all moneys received by the said administratrix or with which she has become charged or had disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the Vouchers in support of the disbursements. He finds a balance of \$1314.14 & to be due by the said adminr. to the said estate on the 20th day of November 1855, with interest thereon from that day.
