Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June last at the request of John H. Griffin, administrator of the Estate of W<sup>m</sup> Griffin, deceased, he appointed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of July last at his Office at the Courthouse of Said County for receiving proof of debts or demands against the said decedent in his Estate and posted a Notice of such time & place to the Creditors of the Said Estate and all others concerned, at the front door of the Court house of Said County, on the first day of two successive terms of the County Court of Said County to wit; of June and July Term last.
