

Settled a previous account showing a balance due the Estate of \$4709.52 on the 31st of December 1856, which is herewith returned as it has been recorded. That he found it impossible to bring this balance into this account, against a Legatee account, showing which of the Legatee had been paid. That William Pinck by his Will directed his Estate to be kept together for the support of his family, and as each child came of age, his or her share to be allotted, and in the account stated above the Commissioner has simply taken the sums of the Negroes against the interest on the Mortgage balance and applied that to the disbursements, which were for the support of the children. That for the years 1862, 1863, 1864 and a part of 1865, the receipts and disbursements were in Confederate States Currency, and he found it necessary to reduce it to U. States Currency, taking the middle of each year as the average and finding it 2 for one in 1862, 8 for one in 1863, 23 for one in 1864 and 50 for one in 1865. He states further that the County Court at its December Term 1863, authorized the Administrator to invest whatever money he had in hand belonging to William Pinck's Estate, in Six per cent Virginia or Confederate States bonds, and the Administrator says that acting under the said Order he invested some \$4000, in Confederate States Bonds.
