I now all now by these present, that I Mark A. James of the County of Southampton,
and State of Virginia, in ill health, but of sound and disposing mind and memory,
do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, so wit, as
First. My Will is that all of my just debts by my Executrix herein after mentioned,
be paid as soon after my deceas'd as practicable.

Item. I give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Angelina James, the tract of
Land upon which I now reside, together with the whole of my household and
Kitchen furniture, also my Still and Cider fixtures, Casks &c, also one half
of my Cattle and Hogs and one Yoke of Oxen, also one bay Mare (Jenny)
also my Brough and Buggy and two sets of Harness belonging thereto, and half
of my farming implements and tools, the horse Cart and wheels.

I leave to Rebecca Harbold the wife of Joseph Harbold all of the property
now in Greenville County State of Virginia, which she records of said County will
have, during her life, and at her death, I give the whole of her children
and their heirs forever, said property.

I give, devise and bequeath to my Nephew Benjamin Allen James, my tract
of Land lying near Person's Mill, commonly known as the "Mill Pond tract,"
also my tract of Land lying near Hebrew Church on both sides of the
Jerusalem road, bounded on the West by the flat Swamp, and on the South by
the Land belonging to Harry Moore and. also one half of my Cattle,
and Hogs, One half of my farming implements and tools, also my
Waggon and the Mule called (White Jack,) also all of my Black
smith Tools, to be his and his heirs forever.

The remainder of my Estate, if any, after all of my just debts are
paid, I give to my beloved wife Angelina James, together with all
the property I have given her, in this my last will and Testament, to
be hers forever. And lastly, I do nominate and appoint my said Nephew
Benjamin Allen James, to be Executor to this my last Will Testament
without the usual requirement of giving Security and the usual commis-
sions is not to be allowed him. No witness whereof I have hitherto
set my hand and affixed my Seal this the 9th day of June A.D.
One Thousand eight hundred and Sixty eight.
