(This last Will & Testament of Nancy Kitchen died, was proved by the Oaths of J. L. Dolis and E. F. Inry, the subscribers, who appeared thereunto & ordered to be recorded, and Shugars Laine the Executor thereof, who appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the Executorship thereof, and the Motion of Joseph A. Inry who made Oath & requested with Gilbert Inry & John W. Inry, his securities, (who justified on Oath as to their sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$400, Conditioned according to law, which bond having a Stamp of the Internal Revenue of the U.
