To the County Court of Southampton County, Your Commissaries report to the Court that on the day of March A. James the administrator of Henry Harrison died exhibited before your Commissaries a Statement of all the money which he the said Mark A. James, had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed, within the time embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissaries embraced the said acct. in the list of Creditors, whose accounts were before them for settlement, which was posted up at the front door of the Court house of said County on the first day of Sept. Court last, and on the date of this report, (ten days having elapsed since the said account was embraced in said list,) made up and completed the foregoing account of the said M. A. James administrator of the estate of the said Henry Harrison died, and on the 31st day of December 1867 finds a balance of \$149.83 due from the adm. to the said Estate, of which sum \$114.15 is interest (the account is supported by satisfactory vouchers &c and the adm. has given such bond as the law requires, the penalty thereof and the securities thereof and suppresses the opinion of the Commissaries.) Given under my hand as Commissaries aforesaid, the day & year first aforesaid.
