Item third. I give to my son A. B. Urquhart's wife Eliya Ann Urquhart & her heirs forever two of the above shares likewise.

Item fourth. I give my watch to my daughter M. A. St.illard.

Item fifth. I give my Sewing Machine & my Piano, to my daughter Rebecca W. Urquhart.

Item sixth. I give my Silver Spoons to be equally divided between my sons George S. Urquhart, M. M. Urquhart, Whitman H. Urquhart.

Item seventh. I give glass & earthen ware of every description to my sons George S. Urquhart, M. M. Urquhart & Whitman H. Urquhart.

The property as given above to my son J. St. Urquhart's wife Martha S. Urquhart, I wish to be held in trust by my son William Urquhart for the benefit of said Martha S. Urquhart & hers for her use.

The property as given above to my son A. B. Urquhart's wife, Eliya A. Urquhart, I wish to be held in trust by son J. W. Urquhart, for the use & benefit of said Eliya A. Urquhart.

I hereby appoint my sons W. & J. W. Urquhart, Executors of this my last Will & Testament. Witness my hand & Seal this 28th day of February 1869.

At a Quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton County, held at the Court House there of, on Monday the 15th day of March A.D. 1869. This last Will & Testament of Eliya B. Urquhart, Sub. was this day fully proved by the Oaths of James E. Selwell & Thomas Simmons two of the subscribing witnesses thereto & was thereupon ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of William Urquhart & Joseph W. Urquhart the Executors named in the said Will, who made Oath as the Law directs & entered into a bond in the penalty of Twelve hundred dollars, Conditioned according to Law, with M. M. Urquhart & W. St. Urquhart his Securities thereon, (who justified no Oath as to their Sufficiency) & which said bond being acknowledged by the Obligors thereon, is ordered to be recorded. Stamps of the Sec. Treas. of the United States to the amount of One dollar being affixed thereto and duly cancelled. Certificate is granted the said William Urquhart and Joseph W. Urquhart for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form. A Stamp of the Internal Revenue of the United States to the amount of One dollar, being affixed thereto and duly cancelled.
