

daughters or daughters, as a house & for the use of time & theme & for no other purpose, provided that they shall pay, after my decease to my son Elijah J. Williams, One hundred & fifty dollars, & this I do in consideration of the natural love & affection that I bear for them.

Item 3rd; After the decease of said Edwin K. Williams, my son, & the death in marriage of all his daughters, I will & bequeath said sum & profits or such of it as may then remain to the then surviving children of my son Edwin K. Williams, to be divided equally among them.

Item 4th; I appoint my son Elijah J. Williams Executor of this my last Will & Testament, & wish that no security may be required of him as such Executor. Given Under my hand & Seal this 16th day of May 1818.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 19th day of July 1819.
This last Will & Testament of Elijah J. Williams decd. was proved by the Oaths of Elliott S. Story & Joseph C. Charles the Subscribing witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Elijah J. Williams the Executor therein named, who made Oath as he lawfully, subscribed into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars, Conditioned according to Law, (the will requiring no security to be taken & the Court requiring none,) Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form. It being declared in Oath that its value real & personal does not exceed in value the sum of One thousand dollars.

I, Temperance Jagers of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, do make this my last Will & Testament in manner & form as follows—
I give & bequeath unto Nancy Lewis daughter of John Lewis & Catherine his wife, one feather bed & furniture, one trunk & forty dollars in cash, to have her heirs forever.

Ist; The balance of my Estate wholly & solely to Roxana F. Jagers, my Grand daughter to her & her heirs forever, that is if she should live to have heirs & if not I wish it equally divided between Robert Traver, Robert Lewis & William F. Rose, to them & their heirs forever. Now I do hereby constitute & appoint Yachariah Tugel Executor to this my last Will & Testament, revoking all other Wills & Testaments heretofore made by me in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 10th day of November One thousand eight hundred & Sixty three.
