1st; I, desire all of my honest debts to be paid, and in furtherance of this end, I, desire my chattel Estate to be sold and the proceeds to be applied to the payment of my indebtedness.

2nd; I, will and bequeath unto Emily Maria Elizabeth Ann Weston, (with whom I have lived for the last several years,) as my wife, (45) forty five acres of my Land, together with all the improvements, buildings, & fixtures, (for which I have a deed,) to her and her heirs forever.

3rd; I, will and bequeath unto Mary Crocker, my sister, and the wife of Hardy Pickett, (5) five acres, or the balance of my Land, to her and her heirs forever. Signed
