I James R. Jagers of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills made by me in any manner and form following, Vitz;

1st. I wish my Executor when I shall hereafter pass as soon after my death as he may think best, sell all of my Chattered Estate, pay my just debts &c.

2nd. I leave to Mary Jagers Col. during her natural life or while she may remain unmarried, one third part of my Estate, of every kind whatsoever, and at her death or marriage, I give the same, to her Children, say Richard W. Jagers, Mary W. Jagers, Elizabeth A. Jagers, Fannie Jagers, Martha A. Jagers, William A. Jagers and Luther Jagers, to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever.

3rd. I give the balance of my Estate of every kind whatsoever to the following named persons (Children of the said Mary Jagers Col.) To wit; Richard W. Jagers, Mary W. Jagers, Elizabeth A. Jagers, Fannie Jagers, Martha A. Jagers, William A. Jagers and Luther Jagers, all of which I give to them, equally to them and their heirs forever.

4th. I do hereby constitute and appoint Ben E. Pope, my Executor. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 30th day of April 1871.
