The Commissioner states Specially at the request of the Executor, that the balance due from him to the Estate is derived entirely from the rents and profits of the property in the County of Granbrier in the State of West Virginia, and belongs under the Will of said Henry, equally to Joseph M. Henry, Sallie B. Buford, formerly Henry, the infant children of C. K. Kincaid and Mary Ann Goddard. That there are and was due the Estate and Uncollected, on account of the rents and profits of the property in the County of Granbrier, the several amounts contained in the Statement below, which it has not been in the power of the Executor to collect up to this time in consequence of the impoverishment and distress of the people in that County, occasioned by the late war, and especially of Mr. Samuel Kincaid, the party who had possession of the property, at the death of said Henry, and who has been continued in the Management of the same by the Executor since. That the faithful efforts of the said Kincaid to protect the property during the war, and his satisfactory Management of the same, since the war, under the direction of the Executor, have induced him to continue the said Kincaid in the same position, under the firm conviction that the Estate would be benefited in the end, even if he failed to pay any portion of his present indebtedness.

The Commissioner further states at the request of the Executor, that there are judgments due the Estate in the County of the County of Southampton, Sussex, and Greensville, and Sundry accounts due at the time of the death of said Henry, which the Exr. has used every means in his power to collect, but without success up to this time. The Executor has kept regular annual accounts of the rents, profits and expenses of the property in Granbrier, which will be exhibited when required.
