

In the Name of God, Amen, I, Julius Thomas Clayton, being of sound mind and
 by the blessing of God in good health, & being Eighteen years old the 16th day of
 November last, having joined the Army of Virginia, and knowing that I might
 as my last will and Testament.
 Article 1st; I give and bequeath to my Brother Allen Augustus Clayton, all the
 interest in the Chattel Estate bequeathed to me by my Father's Will and now in
 possession of my Mother, to wit, all my interest in the Negro, Stock of
 Hare in the Land now in possession of my Mother, of the Land of Virginia and
 make it a valid Gift, in fact I make my brother Allen Augustus Clay-
 ton my sole heir of everything that I can give him as a minor,
 But if my Brother Allen Augustus Clayton should die before I do
 I then desire all the interest that I can devise away in the above
 mentioned property shall be equally divided between my Cousin Robert
 McTear, Allen Margaret Collier, Hugh and James Stephenson, the
 children of Alfred J. Stephenson and Elizabeth Anne Stephenson, and I further
 wish the above divisions of the Negro should be made without
 expiring any one of them to sale.
 Article the 2^d; I constitute my Brother Allen Augustus Clayton,
 or my Cousin Robert McTear my Executor to carry into effect
 my foregoing wishes. Signed and Sealed this 25th
 day of May 1861, in the presence of the following witnesses.
