Whereupon it is ordered that the said Will be recorded as the last Will & Testament of the said Daniel W. Orth. And that the said Wm. B. Whaley one of the Executors named therein appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself any part of the burden of the Execution thereof. On the motion of Elliott L. Story the other Executor therein named who made oath according to law & together with Charles W. Nicholson and James Wells his Securities, (who justified no oath as to their Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Three Thousand Dollars, conditioned according to law, which Bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Elliott L. Story for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form."
