In the name of God Amen I Goodman Horn of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of
 this life I therefore make and ordain this my last will and Testament, In the following manner
 to wit:

Art 1st after paying all my just Debts I dispose of the balance of my Estate as follows.

Art 2nd I leave all the balance of my Estate to my wife Martha Horn as long as she lives or remains
 my widow except one horse and work ox or at her death or marriage I desire all my property
 both real and personal to be sold and the proceeds Equally Divided between my Children that
 may at that time be living

Art 3rd I Give to my son Robert Horn one horse call the Pony but is to stay on the farm
 as long as I live

Art 4th I Give to my son Harrison Horn my work ox and he also is to stay on the farm until
 my Death or until he becomes of age - I likewise make constitute and appoint my wife
 Martha Horn without security to be my Executor to this my last will and Testament hereby
 revoking all other wills made by me

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 18th day of November 1872
 This last will and Testament of Goodman Horn decd was proved by the oaths of Thomas C. Drith &
 Jesse C. Drith the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded; and on the motion of
 Martha Horn the executrix therein named who made oath according to law and intended into and ack-
 nowledged in bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs - but with-
 out security, the will directing that no security should be required and the Court requiring same -
 which bond is ordered to be recorded - Certificate is granted the said Martha Horn for Attorney &
 probate of the said will in due form
