Item 6th I give to my son Paul H. Brumby at the death of my wife, all the lands which I have bequeathed to her, provided he is Twenty one years old at her death. But if he is not Twenty one years old at her death, then I wish the land to be rented out for the benefit of all my children at Twenty one years of age he shall take possession of it.

Item 7th If any of my children should die before arriving at Twenty one years of age I desire his portion shall be equally divided among the survivors, I do not desire any of my lands to be sold under any circumstances.

Item 8th I hereby appoint my Father James Brumby sole executor of this my last Will and Testament. And ask that the Court will not require of him any security for the settlement of my estate - Signed and sealed with my own hand this 26th day of March 1873.

Certificate is granted the said James Brumby for obtaining a Probate of the will of James H. Brumby, in which he is named as executor - provided in the Court on the 21st instant in due form.
