 to be equally divided amongst his children.

I further give unto my son Simon Barron the best suit of my wearing cloaths
 and my rest of my wearing cloaths should be equally divided between my
 sons John and Thomas Barron jr.

my will and desire is that all my estate both real & personal not already disposed
 of be sold by my executors for the best price that can be had and the money
 arising thereon to be equally divided between ^{my} seven children & to wit John
 and Thomas's part to be divided amongst his children Simon & Elizabeth's part
 to be divided amongst her children Jane Sarah & Fortune I do hereby
 empower my executors to convey by good deeds a good and lawful title to all
 the land ordered by me to be sold to any purchaser whatsoever as I might
 have done myself had I been living my will and desire is that my
 estate be not appraised and lastly I do here constitute and appoint
 Richard Woory and Joseph Shillie and my loving wife Elizabeth
 Barron my whole and sole executors of this my last will and testament
